

# GENERAL REGULATIONS



This document contains the general regulations for the BetonKanoRace 2020 in Utrecht. Further information will be published in the regulations for construction and competition. For questions please see the contact details at the bottom of the page

1. Registration for the BetonKanoRace 2020 is open until the 15th of March 2020. All participants receive payment requirements in order to participate. By paying the fee for the race, participants automatically accept all regulations given by the organization: general regulations, competition regulations and the regulations for the construction. The structural report for the canoe must be submitted before the 1st of May 2020.
2. The fees are 25,- per participant and 185,- per canoe. These prices give access to the competition area, campsite, breakfast on Saturday and Sunday, lunch on Saturday and dinner on Friday and Saturday and the other facilities. Participants will receive a wristband at arrival that always needs to be worn during the event.
3. A campsite is provided by the organization which is opened from the 29th of May 2020 13:00 till the 31st of May 2019 12:00. It must be silent at the campsite at 23:00 until 7:00 the next day. Before departure make sure the campsite is left behind clean.
4. Both at the campsite and at the race area it is not allowed to have drugs, strong liquor, glassware, open fires, bring animals or expand activities. Both places are also not accessible for non-boat carrying vehicles.
5. At the race site it is not allowed to have any sound enhancing products or horns.
6. Everything that has been brought by a team to the event must be taken back to home or thrown in the container at the location. This also includes canoes, tents, etc.
7. Swimming and taking place in a canoe is fully on the participants own risk. Safety jackets are recommended. The water depth is 10 m in some places.
8. Exits and passageways always needs to be accessible during the whole weekend. All participants must follow the instructions given by the organization, the committee, the rescue teams and any other public authorities.
9. By law, an alcohol permillage higher then 0.5 is not allowed when using the canoe. Also drinking below the age of 18 is strictly prohibited. The organization can disqualify teams by breaking this rule.
10. Participation for the BKR2020 is completely at own risk. The organization is not responsible for injuries, theft or loss of property of participants.
11. Sponsorship may only be visible on the canoe, tents and t-shirts.
12. Costs for damage done to property of the organization, other teams or the location holder will be charged on the person that caused it.
13. If the regulations are broken in any way, the organization holds the right to take appropriate measures.
14. In case where the regulation do not provide the information needed, the organization has the right to create additional regulations and apply appropriate measures.
15. The organization has the right to change the regulations were needed, when the regulations are changed it will be communicated to all participants.
16. When the event is cancelled due to force majeure, the organization is not liable for costs incurred.
