



Competition regulations

BetonKanoRace 2023

1. The competition consists of three different races:

• 50 m • 100 m • 200 m

The 50, 100 and 200 meter races will be divided into three different categories:

Men • Women • Mixed

- Two members will race per team. Every educational institution must assign two captains which will
 receive more detailed instructions including briefings prior the race. They are expected to keep their
 teams updated.
- 2. The general structure of the tournament consists of multiple stages in which a total of four canoes compete at the same time.









- The team that wins the race will advance to the next stage. The numbers of stages depends on the amount of applicants.
- 3. In order to compete the canoes must require the following:
 - The canoe must be built according to the construction regulations¹.
 - The racenumber on the canoe must be visible at all times. The numbers for the canoes will be distributed by the organization prior to the race.
- 4. Penalties can be given by the organization when a false start occurs, the canoe doesn't stay in it's prescribed lane or it obstructs a differnt team.
 - This can be in the form of a lower ranking or complete disqualification. The decisions made by the organization are final.
- 5. Communication between teams and competition organization must occur via the respective captains.
- 6. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 fastest teams for each different race. Additional prizes are given based on the following aspects:

Most innovative canoe
 Sustainability prize

• Lightest canoe • Heaviest canoe • Unluckiest team

- 7. The prizes will be awarded by a team of experts within concrete and construction. The decisions made by the team of experts are final.
- 8. After the race, the track must be cleared immediately.
- 9. Instructions regarding passing ships or other waterway users have to be followed immediately regarding their and our safety.
