



Terms and conditions

BetonKanoRace 2023

1. Registration for the BetonKanoRace 2023 is open up to the 5th of March 2023. All participants receive an invoice which has to be paid in order to participate. By complying to this invoice, participants automatically agree with all regulations enforced by the organization, i.e.: terms and conditions, competition and construction regulations.¹ As for the structural report concerning the canoe, adequate information must be submitted before the 24th of April 2023.
2. The participation fees are €32,50 per participant and €200 per canoe. These fees include:
 - Access to the campsite
 - Dinner on Friday
 - Breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday
 - Breakfast on Sunday
 - Access to the festivities on Friday and Saturday
3. Participation for the BKR2023 is completely at one's own risk. The organization is not responsible for injuries, theft or loss of property.
4. Every participant must follow the instructions of the organization, safety teams, security and other governmental organisations.
5. A campsite is provided by the organization which is accessible from the 12th of May 2023 13:00 till the 14th of May 2023 12:00. Due to the campsite's noise policy, silence is requested at the campsite from 23:00 till 7:00 the next day. Before departure you are asked to make sure the campsite is left in clean conditions.
6. Both at the campsite and at the race area it is not allowed to have glassware, open fires, bring animals or expand activities. The race area is not accessible for non-boat carrying vehicles. Parking spaces are available at both the race area and the camping site.
7. Every team must leave the camp and event site clean and proper. Also it is expected that everything that has been brought by a team to the event must be taken back home or dumped in the specified containers. In case this is not complied to, the organisation can charge costs to the team.
8. Participants receive a wristband upon arriving at the event. The wristband verifies the participation and must be worn during the event.
9. Promotional material (i.e. branding, logos, etc.) may only be visible on the canoe and t-shirts. Further promotion can be discussed with the organization prior the event.
10. Exits and passageways always need to be accessible during the whole weekend.
11. By law, a blood alcohol level higher than 0.5 is not allowed when occupying a canoe or concrete canoe. The organization can disqualify teams upon breaking this rule.
12. Swimming at the event and riding the canoe is completely at the participants' own risk. Safety jackets are therefore recommended.
13. During the event, by Dutch law, underage drinking is forbidden. This means that drinking below the age of 18 is not allowed. The organisation can disqualify or remove people from the event upon breaking this rule.
14. If the regulations are broken in any way, the organization holds the right to take appropriate measures.
15. In cases where the regulations do not provide the information needed, the organization has the right to make additional regulations and apply appropriate measures. Every team will be notified when regulations are changed.
16. The organization has the right to change the regulations when needed, when the regulations are changed it will be communicated to all participants.
17. Costs resulting from damage inflicted to property of the organization, other teams or the location holder will be charged to the team in cause.
18. In case the event is canceled due to force majeure, the organization is not liable for costs incurred.
