

Terms and Conditions

Betonkanorace 2024

1. Throughout this document, the term “BKR2024” shall refer to Betonkanorace 2024 which takes place in Enschede.
2. Throughout this document, the term “organization of BKR2024” shall refer to any individual which is part of ConceptT’s BKR-committee or part of the team of activists gathered by the BKR-committee.
3. Registration for BKR2024 shall remain open until the 8th of March 2024.
4. Participation in the races and associated event activities shall be confirmed solely upon the completion of payment for the corresponding invoice, meaning that the payment must be fulfilled before the event. If this request is not fulfilled, teams can be excluded from the event.
5. The individual signing the registration form acknowledges automatic agreement to abide by the Terms and Conditions, all pertinent competition regulations, and construction regulations as outlined and made available on the official website of BKR2024 (www.betonkanorace.eu). Furthermore, said signatory acts on behalf of the entire team, indicating their collective acceptance of the Terms and Conditions.
6. A structural report, containing information regarding the canoe’s construction and integrity, must be submitted no later than the deadline of the 26th of April 2024.
7. The participation fees for BKR2024, amounting to €35 per participant and €200 per canoe includes the following amenities and services:
 - a. Access to the designated campsite
 - b. Dinner provided on Friday
 - c. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner provided on Saturday
 - d. Breakfast provided on Sunday
 - e. Access to the festivities organized by the BKR on both Friday and Saturday
 - f. Note: These costs do not include any beverage consumptions, nor do they include any expenses made by the organization for cleanup of leftover items or retrieval of canoes. If canoes are not retrieved by teams themselves, additional charges may apply. These will be billed to the participating institution (if applicable).

12. Upon arrival at the event, participants will be provided with a wristband, which serves as tangible proof of their participation. This wristband must be always worn throughout the duration of the event. Access to the camping site and festivities scheduled for Saturday will be strictly available upon the possession and display of this wristband.
13. Promotional material (i.e., branding, logos, etc.) may only be visible on the canoe and t-shirts. Further promotion must be discussed with the organization prior to the event. Not adhering to the instructions from the BKR2024, regarding the promotional material, might result in the disqualification of a team and/or exclusion from the event.
14. Throughout the duration of the weekend, it is imperative to ensure that all exits and passageways always remain accessible. Deliberate obstruction of these pathways may result in disqualification and/or exclusion of the event.
15. It is mandated by law that any participant occupying a (concrete) canoe with a blood alcohol level exceeding 0.5 is in violation of the law. Consequently, the organization of BKR2024 reserves the right to disqualify teams found to be in breach of this regulation.
16. Participation in water-related activities, including swimming or occupying a canoe, is undertaken entirely at one's own risk. It is strongly advised that participants consider their own swimming qualities and to wear safety jackets as a precautionary measure if needed.
17. Throughout the entirety of the event, it is imperative to adhere to the legal prohibition against the consumption of alcohol by underage participants. Failure to comply to this law will result in the disqualification of the races and/or exclusion from the event.
18. If any rules stated in the Terms and Conditions, or if any instructions are not followed, the organization of the BKR2024 hold the right to take appropriate measures.
 - a. In instances where existing regulations do not address specific circumstances, the organization holds the right to enact supplementary regulations and take appropriate measures.
 - b. Notification of any changes to regulations or instructions shall be provided to every team.
19. Any costs arising from damage inflicted upon property provided or facilitated by the organization of the BKR2024, may be charged to the participant and/or team deemed responsible for such damages. Additionally, measures such as disqualification from the races and/or exclusion from the event might be taken into consideration.
20. The organization of BKR2024 shall not provide refunds if a participant and/or team is excluded from the races or the event.
