# General terms & conditions

## ConcreteCanoeRace 2025

**This document contains the general regulations for the Concrete Canoe Race 2025 in Eindhoven, from the 2<sup>nd</sup> until the 4<sup>th</sup> of May 2025. Further information can be found in the race regulations, construction regulations, and on the website.**

1. Registration for the event is open until the **28<sup>th</sup> of February 2025**. All participants receive two separate invoices which have to be paid in order to participate. By complying to the invoices, participants automatically accept the regulations as stated in the general terms & conditions, the race regulations, and the construction regulations.
2. The participation fees are €35,- per participant and €200,- per canoe, which includes the following:
  - Access to the campsite
  - Dinner on Friday
  - Breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday
  - Breakfast on Sunday
  - Access to the festivities on Friday and Saturday
3. Participation in the race is completely at your own risk. This means the organization cannot be held responsible for injuries, theft, or participants' property loss.
4. Participants that cannot swim must wear a life jacket in and around the water. These will be provided by the organization.
5. A campsite is provided by the organization of which further information regarding access times, noise policy and other regulations implied by the organization must be followed.
6. Glassware, open fires, smoking, animals, and large-scale activities are prohibited at the campsite and race area.
7. Every team must leave the campsite and race area clean and proper. It is expected that everything that has been brought by a team to the event is taken back home or dumped in the specified containers. In case this is not complied to, the organisation can charge costs to the team.
8. Participants will receive a wristband at arrival that needs to be worn at all times during the event.
9. Sponsorship may only be visible on shirts, canoes and tents on the campsite. Further promotion can be discussed with the organization.
10. Exits and passageways cannot be blocked at any time. In case of an emergency, all participants must follow the instructions of the committee, the volunteers, the rescue team, and any of the public authorities.
11. By law an alcohol promillage higher than 0.5 is not allowed when using a canoe. The organization has the right to exclude alcohol-consuming participants.
12. During the event, by Dutch law, underaged drinking is forbidden. This means drinking below the age of 18 is not allowed. The organization can disqualify or remove people from the event upon breaking this rule.
13. If the regulations are broken in any way, the committee holds the right to take appropriate measures.
14. Costs of damage to property of the organization, the location holder or other teams can be charged on the person that caused it.
15. In the case where the regulations do not suffice, the committee is free to create additional regulations and apply fitting measures. Every team will be notified when regulations are changed.
16. If the event is canceled due to force majeure, the organization is not liable for costs incurred.
