

General terms & conditions



ConcreteCanoeRace 2026

This document contains the general regulations for the Concrete Canoe Race 2026 in Twente from 5 to 7 June 2026. Further information can be found in the race regulations, the construction regulations, and on the website.

1. Registration for the event is open until 31 March 2026. All participants will receive two separate invoices, which must be paid in order to participate. By paying the invoices, participants automatically accept the regulations as stated in the general terms & conditions, the race regulations, and the construction regulations.
2. The participation fees are €35 per participant and €200 per canoe. This includes:
 - Access to the campsite
 - Dinner on Friday
 - Breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday
 - Breakfast on Sunday
 - Access to the festivities on Friday and Saturday
3. Participation in the race is entirely at your own risk. The organization cannot be held responsible for injuries, theft, or loss of participants' property.
4. Participants who cannot swim must wear a life jacket in and around the water.
5. A campsite is provided by the organization and is accessible from 5 June 2026 at 12:00 until 7 June 2026 at 12:00. Tent pegs used at the campsite may not penetrate the ground deeper than 30 cm. Due to the campsite's noise policy, silence is required between 23:00 and 07:00. Before departure, you are requested to ensure that the campsite is left clean and tidy.
6. Glassware, open fires, animals, and large-scale activities are prohibited at the campsite and race area.
7. Every team must leave the campsite and race area clean and orderly. All items brought to the event by a team must be taken home or disposed of in the designated containers. If this rule is not complied with, the organization may charge the associated costs to the team.
8. Participants will receive a wristband upon arrival, which must be worn at all times during the event.
9. Sponsorship may only be displayed on shirts, canoes, and tents at the campsite. Any additional promotion must be discussed with the organization.

10. Exits and passageways must not be blocked at any time. In case of an emergency, all participants must follow the instructions of the committee, volunteers, the rescue team, and any public authorities.
11. By law, an alcohol level exceeding 0.5‰ (promille) is not permitted when operating a canoe. The organization reserves the right to exclude participants who have consumed alcohol.
12. During the event, Dutch law prohibits underage drinking. This means that consuming alcohol under the age of 18 is not allowed. The organization may disqualify or remove individuals from the event if this rule is violated.
13. If the regulations are violated in any way, the committee reserves the right to take appropriate measures.
14. Costs resulting from damage to property belonging to the organization, the venue owner, or other teams may be charged to the person responsible.
15. In cases where the regulations are insufficient, the committee reserves the right to establish additional regulations and implement appropriate measures. All teams will be notified if regulations are amended.
16. If the event is cancelled due to force majeure, the organization is not liable for any costs incurred.
17. During the event, photo and video footage will be recorded and may be published on the digital channels of the Concrete Canoe Race 2026 organization.
